ZURI RECOMMENDS

SIGNATURE SUNSET CRUISE

2 hours – \$190 per two

Experience the most magical moments of Kendwa whilst sailing its waters. With sundowners served on board, this is the perfect ending to a perfect day.

- The boat can be booked for special occasions with capacity of 8 people

SNORKELLING TRIP TO MNEMBA ISLAND

Half-day – \$220 for two

Enjoy a half-day private boat tour with snorkelling around the most visited Zanzibari site, the Mnemba Island. If you are lucky enough, you might spot a group of playful dolphins along the way.

DIVING AROUND ZANZIBARI REEFS

EXPLORE ZANZIBAR

STONE TOWN

Half-day or combined — from \$262 for two

Take a tour of the historic capital and its buildings, the famous doors, and the stories from the ancient times of the Sultans, Arabs and Europeans in Zanzibar. Understand its history by visiting places such as the Slave Markets, Anglican Cathedral, Palace of the Sultans, the old Arabic fort and the Forodhani Park.

STONE TOWN 'BEFORE YOU FLY'

Full-day — \$550 for two

Enjoy a view of the skyline whilst taking a 30-minute boat ride from Stone Town to reach Prison Island, named from its first usage as a prison. Now the island is home to the old giant tortoises that you will meet whilst getting to know more about the history of the island.

EXPLORE ZANZIBAR

CHUMBE ISLAND

Full day — \$110 per person

Embark on an ecotourism excursion to the private protected area of Chumbe Island and experience one of the most pristine coral reefs in the whole of Eastern Africa and encounter an abundance of flora and fauna, such as turtles, reef sharks, coconut crabs (the largest land-living crab in the world), more than 500 species of fish and more than 80 species of birds.

SEAWEED CENTRE

Half-day or combined — from \$312 for two

Visit the Mwani Seaweed Centre to learn about seaweed farming, the second biggest industry on the island. Witness how the local women harvest seaweed and create products like organic soaps and essential oils. You can find them in your bathroom and buy them in the WIMBI Sustainable Shop on the beach.

THE ROCK

Combined only — from \$410 for two, combined with Stone Town

Relax and unwind on a superb beach whilst experiencing the south east. Take a photo at the famous 'The Rock' restaurant and, if you wish, enjoy a lunch on this tiny island or at the opposite beach club.

EXPLORE ZANZIBAR

SPICE TOUR

Half-day or combined — from \$302 for two

Explore all the spices of Zanzibar - from cinnamon, lemongrass and cloves, to nutmeg and others. You can also learn Swahili cooking, taste seasonal fruits and buy your choice of fresh spices.

JOZANI FOREST & BUTTERFLY TOUR

Feed the butterflies in the Butterfly Centre and watch them fly from close-up. This is a project supporting women and their children. Later, explore the Jozani Forest, the magic of its Mangrove trees and the red colobus monkey, one of the rarest primates in Africa that can only be found on Zanzibar.

Meeting the locals in their natural surroundings is an excellent way to get to know them better and understand their culture. During the Kendwa Village Tour all guests can see how local residents are living, to visit their seaweed farm, to meet the village chief, to have a look into some private houses and to see how the locals use the coconut tree to make ropes from coconut fibers. You can also learn how they thatch their roofs, how they plant kasava or bake their bread.

HORSE RIDING

4 km from Zuri (Z Hotel) — \$50 per person for swim/\$65 per person for beach ride

Whether you decide to take a ride on the beach (60 min) or go for an ocean dip (30 min), this is definitely a must try if you want a truly unique experience. We suggest going early in the morning to avoid the heat and the busy beach life. Long trousers are recommended for beach ride, while shorts and swimwear for swims. Safety/riding equipment provided.

MNARANI AQUARIUM TURTLE EXPERIENCE

4,4 km from Zuri — \$10 per person

The Mnarani Centre was set up to rehabilitate and study marine turtles that have been caught in fishing nets, and to ensure that local baby turtles are protected.

- Walk through the village of Nungwi for a truly local experience

NUNGWI ZOO

4,4 km from Zuri — \$10 per person

Meet the local animals in the Nungwi Zoo, and learn more about the Zanzibari fauna. Children will enjoy the interaction with the well-known local monkeys.

GUIDED MOTORCYCLE TOUR

Full-day — from \$320 for two

All visitors of Zanzibar are advised to observe the following rules in order to respect the local norms. For violation of any of the following, visitors may be subject to penalties ranging from \$700 per person.

BEFORE YOU GO

- Zanzibar is a predominantly Muslim island. Please respect this when in or around Stone Town or the villages.
- Women are asked to cover their knees and shoulders.
- Swimsuits and skimpy dresses are restricted at public areas, and allowed on resort premises only. Nudity on the beach is not acceptable.
- Please ask permission from your guide before taking pictures of people.
- Please do not purchase any large shells or coral from local vendors as this promotes the destruction of our fragile marine eco system.
- Drinking alcohol in the public may offend the residents.
- Kissing or displays of affection in public is not customary in Zanzibar.
- When on a walking tour, it is advised to wear comfortable shoes.
